## Tournament Rules 2017/18

1. The tournament is open to all players registered with clubs affiliated to the West Kent Table Tennis Association (WKTTA).
2. To qualify for entry, registered players must have played at least one match in any WKTTA competition prior to 31st December 2017, including Development Division events. To qualify for entry to Junior and Cadet events players must be members of a club or school that has been identified to participate by the WKTTA.
3. The tournament will be conducted under the laws of table tennis as approved by Table Tennis England.
4. To enter "restricted" events players must meet the following conditions:
  - Juniors - Under 18 years of age on 31st December 2017
  - Seniors - Over 18 years and under 40 years of age on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2017
  - Veterans - Over 40 years of age on 31st December 2017
  - Over 60's - Over 60 years of age on 31st December 2017
  - Ladies singles
  - Only one "restricted" event can be entered as they will run concurrently.
5. Players must report to the Control Desk upon arrival.
6. Players who are eliminated from an event will be asked to umpire a subsequent match.
7. Players not available when their match is called may be scratched from the event.
8. The Organising Committee reserve the right to withdraw an event if there are fewer than 3 entrants.
